

GE to Core (UCC) mapping

Starting Fall 2011, all continuing WPU students in the current GE program can satisfy a GE requirement with an equivalent UCC (or Core) course from the same discipline.

Notes:

- All courses at WPU now follow a 4-digit code; e.g. ARTH 1010
- Courses in BANNER will appear with one of the following attributes. Check this attribute before registering.
 - “General Education Requirement”
 - “UCC-Area” (e.g., “UCC-Expression-Literature”)
 - “General Education, UCC-Area” - most UCC/Core courses carry this attribute
- Some courses from the GE program will continue to be offered in the Fall 2011 and Spring 2012 semesters. This is to facilitate ease of transition and provide for a number of students with a wide range of needs.
